In Social Studies we will learn about the four domains of social studies:

<b>History:</b> The study of past events	<b>Geography:</b> The study of the details of the earth's surface including the land, bodies of water, climate, plants, animals and of course- people	<b>Civics:</b> The study of the rights and responsibilities of citizens and of how governments work	<b>Economics:</b> The study of the process of how goods and services are created, sold, bought or exchanged
