In order to secure your seat in our 6th grade class, please plan to attend **2017-18 Registration at Skinner Middle School**. Your student will receive his/her **summer homework** assignments during Registration. This will be your **only registration opportunity**.

- Registration for last name **M - Z** is Saturday, May 20, 2017 from 8:30 – 11:30 am

Please bring the following documents with you to Registration: your child's birth certificate; proof of address (Xcel or water bill, mortgage statement or rental lease) and your child's immunization record. Please also bring payment for your student's student fees (\$60.00) and purchasing optional Skinner gear for your student. The Neighborhood Center at Skinner will also be collecting the after-school student activity fee (\$100/semester – discount for prepayment for both semesters). Please see attached letter for details. Scholarship assistance and income tax credit are available.

Skinner Middle School is happy to announce that we will host **6th Grade Academy on August 7 – 10, 2017 (Mon-Thurs) from 8:00 am – 12:30 pm**. All incoming 6th graders are expected to attend. 6th Grade Academy will jump start the transition from elementary school to a successful middle school experience. We will have more information at Registration in May.
