Skinner Registration Process for 2017-2018

May 6th Last Names starting with A – L & May 20th Last Names starting with M - Z

Skinner Middle School has a two part registration process.

1. Parent/Guardian must physically come to one of Skinner's Pre-registrations to turn in proper paperwork and fill out Skinner Only forms. (No grandparents or siblings unless they have guardianship)
2. Parent/Guardian must log-in to Parent Portal and complete the online registration process or your student **WILL NOT** be registered for a seat at Skinner for 2017-2018 school year. Window dates for online registration - July 17th – August 14th.

After School Programs

All students who are in the building after 3:00 p.m. **MUST** be in an after school program or activity. If you will pick your child up after 3pm, s/he must register with the Neighborhood Center, attend office hours with a teacher (except Wednesday & Friday), and/or get involved with Athletics.

NO LOITERING! We don't have supervision after 3pm unless students are in tutoring, the NC, or Athletics.

1. Sports – Practices start at 3:30 p.m. Students must be in PIE with a teacher or Study Hall with the coach until practice starts.
 2. TAP – (Tardies aren't permitted) ends at 3:30 p.m.
 3. ASI – (After school intervention) ends at 4:00 p.m.
 4. PIE – (Proficiency is Expected) ends at 3:30 p.m. *also known as Office Hours
 5. Neighborhood Center @ Skinner offers various activities for a minimal fee (scholarships are available for families who qualify for free or reduced lunch).
