This will be your **only registration opportunity. 2018-19 Registration is Saturday, May 19 from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm at Skinner Middle School.**

Please bring the following documents with you to Registration: your child's birth certificate; proof of address (Xcel or water bill, mortgage statement or rental lease) and your child's immunization record. Please also bring payment for your student's Chromebook and student fees (\$60.00) and purchasing optional Skinner gear for your student. Regarding fees, if your student currently receives free/reduced pay lunch through DPS, please contact Skinner treasurer, Ms Chavira at 720-424-1527 for information on a reduction in Chromebook/student fees.

8th Grade Families: Skinner will be contacting you to schedule a Registration Conference with Executive Principal Koyama. These conferences are mandatory and student and parent/guardian must be present.

The first day of school for **NEW TO SKINNER 7th and 8th graders** is Monday, August 20, 2018 at 8:00 am. Student will meet their new teachers and learn everything they need to know about being a Skinner Scholar. Mark your calendar for this essential piece of a successful transition to Skinner. Students second day of school is Tuesday, August 21 at the regular start time of 7:25 am.
